## Items **TO NOT** Bring:

The following items are some of the things that are not permitted in the RHs: toasters, "George Foreman Grills", toaster ovens or any appliance using heating coils, paint or pellet guns, tasers, flammable liquids, laser pointers, fireworks, halogen lamps, incense or candles, weapons, pets (fish in 10 gal. max tank are allowed). If you aren't sure what else to bring, please contact the Office of Residence Life and Housing.

## Helpful Tips:

**Operation Identification:** Designed to discourage the theft of student possessions while living in the residence halls. Valuables are engraved with an identification number that can be used by Department of Public Safety (DPS) or local police in the event of theft or loss. This service is provided by DPS.

**Securing your belongings:** Whenever you leave your room, even for a few minutes, be sure to lock your door.

**Storage:** The Office of Residence Life and Housing does not provide additional storage (for luggage, bikes, boxes, etc.). If you need storage, contact a local storage company. All belongings must be removed at the end of each academic year.
